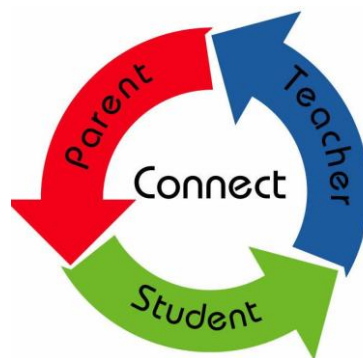


iEducator in Summary

iEducator is a South African web-based maths tutoring program which allows students to master every operation in mathematics, and covers the core operations of the South African maths curriculum for grades 1 to 7. It enables students to take control of their own learning, at their own pace and gain mastery of each topic by logging into the site, watching the training videos and completing a workbook per day. Instructions are easy to follow, with instant feedback and tracking of progress.

The aim of iEducator is to get students performing above their curriculum level and helps to cultivate a manageable daily study routine which ensures capability and confidence in maths, irrespective of the student's ability.

The real advantage of iEducator is that it keeps students, parents and (if applicable) teachers continually in the loop thus optimising the learning process.



Mastery through practice, through leading methods

iEducator ensures that each student achieves mastery of a new concepts which are introduced by a training videos and followed by workbooks, which students can practise on until they are able to complete a workbook within the specified time with a high degree of accuracy. **This approach ensures confidence and capability and is complimentary to the Singapore method, which according to the TIMSS report is the most effective method of mathematics training worldwide.**

South African maths Curriculum

iEducator is the first South African online mathematics training programme for grades 1 to 7, focussing specifically on the South African maths curriculum allowing students to achieve excellent results without expensive maths tutors.

Independent Learning, for lifelong skills

The student is responsible for their own learning. Workbooks are designed to allow students to practice on their own together with online training videos. The ability to study independently is a skill that will benefit the student throughout their lives. A daily study habit works best and it is recommended that students aim for 15-40 minutes per day depending on their grade.

Individualised learning, according to learner's current level

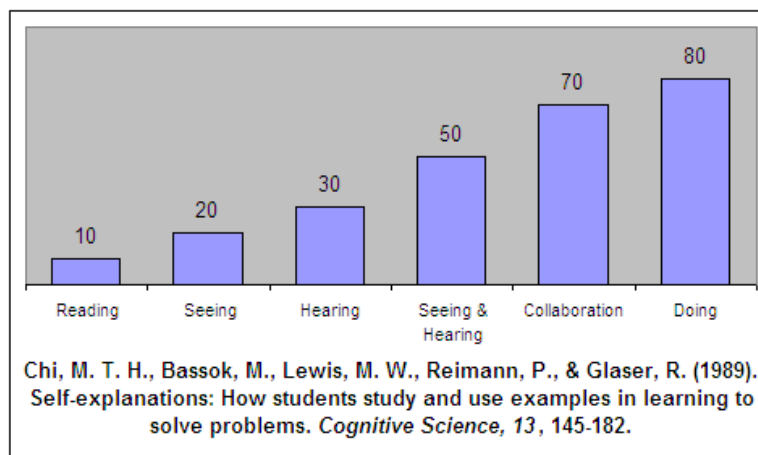
First-time students complete a diagnostic assessment test, which determines their level of competency and places them at the correct starting point on the iEducator program. The programme is designed to challenge those who are currently excelling and provide re-enforcement to those requiring extra support. Time and accuracy are used as performance metrics, enabling the student to perform at their optimum level, with a balance between challenge and comfort.

Accessibility, 100% web based

Students are able to log on to www.iEducator.co.za at any time of the day from any location as long as they have access to a computer and an internet connection.

Interactive Learning, learning through doing

Students are actively engaged in each activity as they learn from doing, not just from sitting passively in front of a screen.



Instant feedback and positive reinforcement

After completing a workbook, students immediately receive a marked copy of their work, which allows them to make corrections, thus eliminating unnecessary errors. Students receive positive feedback and a medal for every successfully completed level, and parents are mailed a certificate.

Tracking of progress, for parents and teachers

For each workbook, students and parents get reports and graphs on progress. In schools, the teacher is also able to view the aggregated results and individual student reports.
